

**PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED PROJECTS TO BE FUNDED  
USING PASSENGER FACILITY CHARGES**

**March 20, 2025**

The Huntsville-Madison County Airport Authority is considering the following projects for Passenger Facility Charge Funding:

<b>Projects</b>	<b>Amount of Use Approval</b>
<b>#120 - Air Cargo Access Road</b>	<b>\$269,652</b>
The Huntsville International Airport required modifications that performed the mill and overlay of the existing air cargo access road and extension of the road to a new intersection with the Wall Triana Highway. The extension portion of the work included grading, paving, striping, storm drainage, and electrical work.	
<b>#121 - Air Cargo Ramp Rehabilitation</b>	<b>232,916</b>
Huntsville International Airport's Air Cargo Ramp Rehabilitation project will include the rehabilitation (mill and overlay) of the pavement surface of the air cargo ramp that was last rehabilitated in 2012, new markings in the rehabilitated areas, replacement of edge light fixtures and cabling, repairs to existing trench drains, and minor grading along the edge of the ramp to promote sheet drainage away from the ramp.	
<b>#122 - F1/F2 Connector Relocation</b>	<b>476,161</b>
Huntsville International Airport's F1/F2 Connector Relocation project will include the demolition of the existing taxiway connectors between Taxiway E and the General Aviation Ramp and construction of new Taxiway F1 and F2 connectors between Taxiway E and the General Aviation Ramp configured to eliminate direct runway access from the General Aviation Ramp. Pavement markings, edge lighting, taxiway guidance signage, and grading associated with the modifications will also be performed.	
<b>#123 - Terminal Concourse Upgrade - Elevator/Escalator</b>	<b>533,101</b>
Huntsville International Airport's Terminal Concourse Upgrade – Elevator/Escalator project will reconfigure the post-security connector between the terminal and concourse replacing the current elevator and escalators with two elevators and four escalators. These improvements will replace equipment that has exceeded its useful life, better accommodate passengers with mobility problems, and improve capacity, safety, and energy efficiency in the connector.	

<b>#124 - Terminal Concourse Upgrade - Elevator/Escalator</b>	<b>333,013</b>
Huntsville International Airport's Terminal Concourse Upgrade – Elevator/Escalator project will reconfigure the post-security connector between the terminal and concourse replacing the current elevator and escalators with two elevators and four escalators. These improvements will replace equipment that has exceeded its useful life, better accommodate passengers with mobility problems, and improve capacity, safety, and energy efficiency in the connector.	
<b>#125 - Taxiway Whiskey Overlay/Rehabilitation</b>	<b>979,544</b>
Huntsville International Airport's Taxiway Whiskey Overlay/Rehabilitation project will rehabilitate (mill and overlay) Taxiways W, G, H, & K, correct depressions in Taxiway L, replace the squared north end of Taxiway W1 with a radiused edge, and rejuvenate paved shoulders. Pavement markings, edge lighting, taxiway guidance signage, and grading associated with the modifications will also be performed.	
<b>#126 - 18L 36R Reconstruction Construction Project</b>	<b>1,232,359</b>
Huntsville International Airport's 18L 36R Reconstruction Construction Project will design and construct the mill and overlay of the full-strength pavement of Runway 18L-36R and rejuvenate the blast pads and runway shoulders. The new asphalt will also be grooved, new pavement markings will be applied, and crack cleaning and sealing will take place where rejuvenation will occur. The swift deterioration of the pavement and the increased presence of FOD are both significant safety concerns, and shutting down the runway to address maintenance issues impacts commercial, cargo, and potentially space aircraft. Rehabilitation of the runway at this time will eliminate all of the issues being experienced by the airport now and in the foreseeable future.	
<b>#127 - Terminal Concourse Upgrade - Concourse Restroom Expansion</b>	<b>286,326</b>
Huntsville International Airport's Terminal Concourse Upgrade – Concourse Restroom Expansion project includes the construction of ADA-Compliant restrooms, a nursing room, a family restroom, and a companion care restroom. None of these facilities are currently available in the concourse. Therefore, the project will allow the airport to accommodate additional passengers it cannot currently accommodate. This work will replace the 34-year-old fixtures in the restrooms with modern, energy-efficient fixtures. This includes low-flow and sensor-operated faucets and toilets, modern HVAC equipment, and LED light fixtures. This work will extend the overall useful life of the building.	
<b>#128 - Concourse Chiller II Replacement</b>	<b>15,879</b>

Huntsville International Airport's Concourse Chiller II replacement project will replace the 34-year old chiller in the concourse with modern, energy-efficient equipment. This work will extend the useful life of the building by replacing the aged equipment that was installed when the building was originally constructed over 34 years ago (typical useful life of the equipment is 10 years).	
<b>#129 - Concourse Improvements - Phase 2 (Wayfinding/FIDS)</b>	<b>66,215</b>
Huntsville International Airport's Concourse Improvement – Wayfinding/FIDS replacement project will result in wayfinding that is ADA-compliant and is designed to be efficiently updated when future changes and building expansions occur. From the airport access roadway through the terminal to the hold room, the wayfinding replacement work will address all of the factors identified (graphic standards, terminology, spacing, maintenance, code compliance, technology) by replacing the outdated, 34-year-old, static wayfinding currently in the building. This work will also extend the useful life of the building by replacing the static wayfinding that was installed when the building was originally constructed as it incorporates modern technology and improves the maintainability and expansion capability of the wayfinding.
